Worship

Welcome

- Check In – How is everyone doing (good things, lessons learned, prayers answered)?

Word

- Read: Luke 2:41-52
- This is one of the only stories about Jesus's life between his birth and his earthly ministry. How do you think Jesus' parents felt?
- What else stands out to you from this passage of scripture?
- What do you think Jesus meant when he said that he needed to "be about the Father's business"?
- Read John 17:4 and Jesus' last words in John 19:30. Jesus talks about finishing the work God had called him to. How does this give us a stencil for success on the spiritual journey?
- Jesus mentions in John 4:34 that there is a fulfillment found in doing God's will. How do we experience this in our lives?
- How can we apply this on a daily basis?
