Pastor's Report

I recently saw a meme that said, "I'm getting tired of living through a historical event." As we come up to the second anniversary of the COVID -19 pandemic, I think that most of us would echo that sentiment. But we do not get to choose which part of history we are a living in, so we press on. No event in recent memory has been so difficult, divisive, and polarizing as this. Everyone has an opinion. Most of these opinions are passionately believed, supported by their interpretation of the information available, their own experiences and personal beliefs.

We have endeavoured, at Callander Bay Church, to try and not take sides in this debate. We have attempted to remain in "the messy middle". But to many, this is not enough, to not choose one side means that you have already chosen the opposite side. I have now served in church leadership for 30 years. In that time, I have served in 3 different churches. Two of these churches have had a split during that time. The issue in both those separations was the same: ministry style. The disagreements centred on traditional vs contemporary worship style. Those arguments have dissipated slightly and now here we are 20 years later, and we have found new things to disagree upon. Now, the issues are Christian Nationalism (a combination of national pride and spiritual entitlement), Deconstructionism (the taking apart of an idea, practice, tradition, belief, or system into smaller components to examine their foundation, truthfulness, usefulness, and impact) and the influence of secular humanism (belief that humanity is capable of morality and self-fulfillment without belief in God.), which has led to massive exodus of young people leaving the church. Now we add another issue: our understanding of Christian liberty and freedom. All these issues have put a great strain on our unity in Christ, both locally and on a national level.

The call of scripture remains consistent. We are called to love (John 13:35), unity. (John 17:23), peace (Colossians 3:15) and a living hope (1 Peter 1:3). At the beginning of 2022, we introduced the 21 days of prayer. Our intent was to pray that we would be connected to Christ and His love. We wanted to pray to keep and maintain our unity in Christ and to live in the peace and hope of Christ.

Last year was another difficult year of ministry at Callander Bay Church. This is the reason for the brevity of our annual report. Most of our regular activities have been put on hold. We switched back and forth between Online services and an In-person/Online combination. Special appreciation to Tyler Yanta for his work on our online service and on our webpage. He has been an amazing gift to our church). In late September and October, we had a COVID-19 outbreak at the church. With the assistance and cooperation of the North Bay Parry Sound Health Unit we were able to navigate through this. Although a lot of things did not happen in 2021, we were able to have a few other activities at Callander Bay Church.

• We joined together with South Shore for an outdoor Good Friday service.

• Wilma Schweitzer and Patricia Attwood did an excellent job putting together our High Power Soccer ministry at the Callander Community Center.

• Denise Boudreau has been leading a small group. They have been switching between Zoom and In-person meetings. Thank you, Denise, for your faithful leadership of this group.

- Bonnie Pannabecker led a women's bible study when we were able to. Thanks Bonnie.
- We were able to hold two Christmas Eve candlelight services.

I am hopeful that as we move into the new year, we will be able to add more ministry options. Already (in 2022) we have added some kid's ministry on Sunday morning, a women's Bible study has started, as well as an Art class led by Janeen Howie. Let's be praying that God would keep us safe and allow us to open even more. Also be praying for how you can help us rebuild some of the ministries here at Callander Bay Church.

We were very saddened by the sudden loss of Wayne Attwood this year. As I walk around the church facility, I see Wayne's handiwork. He designed and built my office. Many of the major projects that the church completed were under his supervision including the installation of the HRV and our connection to the town water supply. He served on our initial steering committee when the church was started 20 years ago. He spoke in our pulpit on many occasions. I appreciated his wisdom, correction, and encouragement. He did everything with a heart of love and service. We are all going to miss him immensely.

Jenn and I are hitting a few milestones of significance this year. The first has already happened. On January 6th we celebrated the 20th anniversary of our ministry at Callander Bay Church. On April 4th, I will be celebrating 30 years of ministry in the Near North between Lakeshore and Callander Bay Church's. In May Jenn and I will be becoming Grandparents for the first time, (As Jordan and His girlfriend Cordelia will be having their first child). In July, Jenn and I will be celebrating our 35th Wedding anniversary. I am thankful for these significant dates they show to me God's goodness and faithfulness.

I'm hoping for a couple more milestones, the first Toronto Maple Leafs Stanley Cup Victory since 1967 and a World Cup victory for the Netherlands. I'd love them to be able to win it for my dad who is going to be 96 this year. I would be okay if the Canadians one it too. First, they must qualify (so close) and then it is still a long shot. But that is wishful thinking. It is better to be anchored to the hope that can only be found in Jesus.

Thank you for the continued opportunity to serve as your Pastor. I may not know a lot, but one thing I do is that God is good. God is faithful. God is sovereign and He rewards those who diligently seek Him. Let us seek Him with all our hearts, together in 2022.
