  experience one of the three D's of Destruction—division, distraction, or discredit to your
  witness. What could you do differently next time an offense occurs?
- Pastor John shared the story of him yelling at the NBA refs. How does distance and disassociation affect our behaviour to others?
- Read: Jeremiah 17:9. What does this verse mean to you?
- Why do we often judge other people and their motives, but have a hard time discerning our own behaviours?
- What do you think of Brant Hansen's quote, "...the heart is deceptive. And that calls for humility above all else, because my heart isn't deceptive because it fools other people. It's deceptive because it fools me."
- Read Psalm 139:23-24. How can this verse help us in this area?
