Word

- Pastor John mentioned several reasons why we may struggle with discipleship like the influence of consumerism on the gospel, the difficulties of life, lack of competency, life pace and stress and the world’s influence. Do any affect you? Are there others that you can think of?
- What is an action step that you can take to move forward in the process of being a disciple who makes disciples?
