When asking for help, it's very tough to do and they make you feel very comfortable and cared for by the help that they offer here.

I've seen from the short time that I've been staying here how they've helped different people in my situation with their particular issues that they need to deal with. I've seen how they reach out to the community with people that come to the door. It's a very caring, very loving environment. I feel very comfortable here; it doesn't feel like a shelter; it feels more like a home environment. I would like to say the staff here have made it really comfortable to be here. Honestly when I first came to the door I didn't know what to expect. They're very welcoming and have been very helpful in helping me figure out what I need to do to progress back into not being homeless. I've been given a safe environment and warm roof over my head, so it's been very nice.
