My name is Devin, and I would like to share a little about who I am and what God has been doing in my life. 3 years ago God brought me to North Bay to serve at Hope Awaits as a Shelter Care Worker. I was living in the Niagara Region and God made it clear to me that He wanted me to move to North Bay. Serving the homeless wasn't something that had been on my radar, but God worked out all the details and brought me to serve at Hope Awaits.

I won't say that leaving family and everything that was familiar to live and serve in a city where I didn't know anyone has been easy. But God has used the last few years to teach and mould me in Him. I have learned so much and for that I am very grateful.

After moving to North Bay God's faithfulness continued. In the Spring of 2022 I was struggling to get proper sleep due to shift work and I wanted to use the gifts and abilities God had given me more fully. I wasn't sure what God had for my future, but in the following months a Shelter Supervisor position was created at Hope Awaits that previously had not existed. God moved me into this role where I could use my abilities more fully, and gave me a vision for supporting clients through mentorship as they move out of the shelter. I had been serving as the Shelter Supervisor for about a year when I learned that Nicole would be stepping down as Executive Director in obedience to God. I have agreed to step in and will be serving as the Executive Director. I am grateful for the opportunity I have had to learn and serve under Nicole's leadership, and I am looking forward to what God has in store.

I had had my own plans of how I wanted to serve God with my life, and never dreamed it would be through working with the homeless. But God always knows what is best, and His ways are not our ways. Please pray for myself and the ministry as we continue to seek God's leading, and that we would honour and glorify Him in everything.
