Not all clients who come to Hope Awaits are what we would think of as a "typical" homeless man. Some of them were well settled in their lives, and later things turned around and they ended up homeless and hopeless. Homelessness is not a choice.

Rather than just providing shelter, we want to be their family, to be people who care about them and pray for them.

Some of our clients don't believe in God and don't want to be involved in any kind

of spiritual things, but I have seen some start to thank God and ask for prayer.

Only through God can we do this ministry. We get clients who do not successfully make it through Hope Awaits' program. I think that maybe not today, but one day in the future, God will work in their lives.

We also help people at the door who come for snacks and clothes. God is helping us reach out to those people. There have been times when we talked with them at the door for hours, listening to their problems and praying for them. I believe God is using us in this era to spread God's word, but not always in the way we expect.
