- The crowd expected a political king, but Jesus was a spiritual Savior. How do our expectations of Jesus differ from who He actually is?
- How can we make sure we are not like the Pharisees, focusing on our own agenda rather than celebrating Jesus?
- Why did Jesus weep over Jerusalem, and what does this reveal about his heart for those who reject him?
- What does it mean that the people did not understand "what would bring them peace"?
- Is there anything that stands out to you from this scripture? What is something that you could apply to your life?
